

IBN-E-SINA LECTURE BY MAJ. GEN. (R) MASOOD ANWAR

Major General (Rtd) Masood Anwar is currently Dean, Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences at Riphah International University, a post he has held for the past 8-years. After doing FCPS-Pathology, he worked in various capacities at Royal Free Hospital, London and Prince Mansoor Military Hospital, Saudi Arabia.



After receiving specialist training in Bone Marrow Transplantation from London and Pessaro, Italy, he is credited with establishing Armed Forces Bone Marrow Transplant Centre inaugurated in 2000. He served as first commandant of the center and made this Center member of International Bone Marrow Transplant Registry through his untiring hard work. He also remained Professor of Pathology at Army Medical College, and Commandant AFIP, Rawalpindi. During his tenure he conceived and established Centre for Research and applied medicine (CREAM). He has been awarded Halal-e-Imtiaz in recognition of his services. He has contributed to 170 publications and more than 200 presentations and conferences. He discovered for the first time the presence of Drug Resistant Falciparum Malaria in Quetta and Sickle β -Thalassemia around Zhob Area. He discovered cytokine mediated Bone Marrow fibrosis in patients with visceral leishminasis in AJK.

He will deliver Ibn-e-Sina Lecture on Haemcon2017, Lahore Theme “Haematology Challenges in Pakistan” in the inauguration session on 16th February, 2017 at 10:00am.
